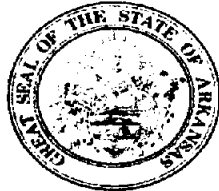

Course Provider Proposals for Beginning / Continuing Education 2018

All Beginning Education may be provided either online or in person in a classroom-type setting.

All Continuing Education must be provided in person in a classroom-type setting.

In accordance with Act 917 of 2017 and Board Rule 2, the Board requires or encourages, as applicable, the following for both Beginning Education and Continuing Education course provider proposals:

I. The Board requires:

1. The course provider must have 10 years' experience in the provider's field of expertise. (For example a licensed lawyer, law enforcement officer, education provider, or other Board-approved field);
2. Allowed instructors must have 5 years' experience in the field of their instruction;
3. An "in-person" course must be given in a Board-approved, neutral (meaning, not on the premises of a licensee) facility;
4. No instruction may be given in firearms or the use of deadly force; and
5. A course provider may establish its fees with Board approval, but if the Board approves more than one course provider, then providers must charge same fee with Board approval.

II. The Board encourages:

1. No principal provider to be wholly owned by only one Board licensee;
2. Statewide coverage, with courses offered in the central, northeast, northwest, southeast, and southwest areas of the state; and
3. A minimum offering of five (5) classes per year for Continuing Education.

All provider proposals are due by November 1, 2017.
